The Cancer Predisposition Clinic is a multidisciplinary clinic developed by Kerri Beckett, MD (pediatric oncologist) and Amy Ott, MS, GC (genetic counselor) to provide comprehensive care for patients who have:

- A known cancer predisposition syndrome
- A strong family history of cancers that may be associated with familial syndromes
- A known family history of a cancer predisposition syndrome
- A new cancer diagnosis that may be due to an underlying genetic syndrome

We currently offer half-day clinics once per week, with plans for expansion as our patient base grows.

Our clinic appointments are tailored to the needs of each patient. We welcome referrals for patients with concerning clinical findings or family history.
